*Though we occasionally have activities on weekends, our synchronous courses are typically scheduled for workday evenings.*

*Fee Waiver for Senior Citizens: Non-degree seeking persons 65 years of age or older shall have their in-state Enrollment Fees waived and are eligible to enroll in any courses offered in the official university semester class schedule on a space-available basis. The Enrollment Fee waiver will not apply to Professional Development Courses, workshops, books and supplies. Classes may be taken for credit or for audit. Note: The senior citizen fee waiver is not available to persons pursuing microcredentials, certificates, or baccalaureate or graduate degrees.
