## BLANTON-NASON-BREWER HALL

- Suite Style with adjoining bathroom
- Sorority Housing
- Mascot: Alice the Buccaneer
- Color: Kelly Green

A close-knit community, centrally located on campus and popular with students interested in fraternity and sorority life. Pet housing is also located in the south side of this building.





## **WEST CAMPUS SUITES**

- Suite Style with in-suite bathroom and common living space
- · Convenience Store
- Mascot: Norm the Wolf
- · Color: Forest Green



This residence community features expanded suite-style housing and has many suites featuring single-occupancy rooms popular with both first-year and upper-class students alike.



## **MISSOURI HALL**

Community style with double and deluxe double rooms. Includes kitchens and community gathering spaces.

#### **RYLE HALL**

Both suite and community style rooms offer a variety of choices.

fully furnished and kitchenette includes a stovetop, oven, and full-size refrigerator

- Campbell residents can pick from all on-campus and off-campus meal plans, or opt out of a meal plan entirely
- · Located next to a "park and save" parking lot

Both single and double occupancy apartments provide upper-class students with a varied experience compared to the traditional residence hall room.

Campbell Apartments are **only** available to returning students and transfer students.

Campbell Apartments remain open during Thanksgiving, winter, and spring break periods at no additional cost to students staying on campus over breaks.





## **Hall Services**

#### **DINING SERVICES**

Along with your room, students will select one of several meal plans, ranging from 15 to 21 meals per week, as well as "Dining Dollars." You'll choose your meal plan after your housing selection opens, usually in April or May. Your student ID card is all you'll need to access your selected plan. #### **COMPUTER ACCESS**

Wireless network access is available campus-wide at Truman. In addition, each residence hall room has high-speed internet access through the campus network.

#### **FURNITURE**

All of Truman's residence halls feature modular furniture, including desks and chairs, drawer space, shelf space, and convertible lofted beds.

#### **LAUNDRY**

Each residence hall has laundry facilities which are included in room rates. No need for coins!

#### **KITCHENS**

Residence halls on campus have community kitchens located on each floor for residents looking to prepare their own food, with the option to check out pots and pans from the hall front desk.



#### **MICROFRIDGES**

For your convenience, Residence Life offers MicroFridge rentals! For \$150 total you can rent a MicroFridge unit for the year. The unit includes a small refrigerator/freezer (2.9 cu. ft.) and microwave. A MicroFridge can be requested through your Housing Application.











#### **PARKING**

Ample parking is available next to each residence hall for students who register for a parking pass from the Department of Public Safety. You can access this registration through your TruView account. For more information about parking or campus police services, visit **police.truman.edu**.

#### **APPLY FOR HOUSING**

There are benefits to applying early for housing! Priority for residence hall room assignments is based upon the date housing applications are submitted. Students can apply as early as Oct. 15, when our housing application opens!
