Environmental Science is for students who are drawn to biology or agricultural science, but also have an interest in applying those subjects towards solving challenges associated with human activity and development.

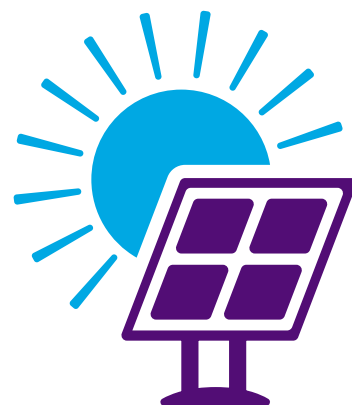
