Cannabis and its production is a complex subject that sits at the center of multi-billion dollar industries across the United States. This program places focus on the biological component while studying the business, marketing, and legal contexts of cannabis and natural medicinals.

This program is interdisciplinary, with tracks in analytical science, cultivation, business/entrepreneurship, and sociology/philosophy. All students will engage in these topics but will specialize in one of these four distinct tracks, and will develop their skills as speakers and writers.
