ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university with an overall undergraduate grade point average of at least 2.75
- Online application and a \$40 application fee
- Statement of Career Goals (uploaded in online application)
- Resume (uploaded in online application)
- Three letters of recommendation (Submit recommender's information in online application)
- Official copies of transcripts from all colleges and universities from which you earned college credit

Note: Truman students do not need to upload their transcript but should list Truman in the academic history portion of their application
